

WARSAW ARCHDIOCESE MUSEUM + THE CATHEDRAL CRYPT

The museum is in Warsaw's Old Town next to the cathedral. The permanent exhibits show sacred and secular works of art from the Middle Ages until the present. The museum's collection includes paintings, sculptures, graphic art, gilt work, clothing, old clocks and furniture. The museum was established in 1938.




MUSEUM OF DOLLHOUSES GAMES AND TOYS
